Heavy-duty binder with three 3" metal rings	The backbone of our program for teaching organization. Please purchase a large, sturdy model, and replace it should it become broken.
Class divider sheets	5, NO "TRAPPER" FOLDERS, PLEASE!
Paper	College-ruled notebook paper; separate sheets, not bound.
Pencil Pouch (one that fastens inside the rings of the binder), containing:	
Pencils	At least 2, with #2 lead.
Pens	2 ball-point, black ink. NO "GEL PENS," PLEASE!
Red Pen	For revising and editing.
Fine Point Black Marker	For detailed map work. Extra-fine, if possible.
Colored Pencils	At least 5 assorted colors.
Highlighter	Color of choice.
Reinforcers	To fix torn-out "holes" in papers.
Glue Sticks	5, for Social Studies and Science Notebooks.

For Math section:

- Calculator (very basic, inexpensive one)
- 2 Spiral Notebooks of $\frac{1}{4}$ " graph paper
- 4 Divider Sheets
- 12" Ruler that fastens into binder rings
- Protractor (clear, see-through, inexpensive one)

Social Studies Notebook	Mead Five-Star, spiral-bound, plastic-covered , 150 pages.
Science Notebook	Mead Five-Star, spiral-bound, plastic-covered , 200 pages.
